# ARTBAR SPECIAL VIEWFINDER LANDSCAPE COLLAGE

Create a transparent landscape in a popsicle stick frame that you can look through.



## MATERIALS

Cellophane (often purchased as gift wrap)

8 popsicle sticks

Pencil

Paper

Scissors

Glue

## **INSTRUCTIONS**

- Using liquid or hot glue (with an adult's help!), glue the ends of 4 popsicle sticks together in a square to make a frame. Repeat to make 2 frames. Let the glue dry completely.
- 2 Trace the outside of the frame onto a piece of paper so that you know the size to make your collage.
- 3 Using different colored pieces of cellophane, create a collage that looks like your favorite landscape—real or imagined! Use a small amount of glue to stick the cellophane together.
- 4 Add a line of glue along the back of your popsicle stick frame.
- 5 Lay the frame over your collage matching up the edges to frame your collage.
- 6 Once it is dry, hold it up to your eye to look through your final creation!
